EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the grounds upon request by Competition Management.
- 2) All horses entering the grounds must also be accompanied by documentation of a negative Coggins test for EIA within the previous 12 months.
- 3) All out-of-state horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Interstate Health Papers dated no more than 10 days before the show.

HOST HOTEL: The Route 66 Morgan Classic Horse Show has contracted with the Embassy Suites for a **special rate of \$114 per night** for our exhibitors. A block of rooms has been reserved, but will be released on May 8th. So, please make your reservations as soon as you can. There is a reservation link on our website: www.horseshowbysandy.weebly.com

PRIZES: Trophies and 6 ribbons will be awarded in all qualifying classes and championships.

STABLING: All stabling requests need to go to stabling manager, Sandy Sessink at 248-207-4956 as early as possible. Stalls are permanent, 10' X 10' with full sliding doors. Stall partitions may not be removed by the exhibitor, for stall wall removal by the fairgrounds, special arrangements must be made and there will be a hefty fee assessed on your entries.

STALL MATS: Elite Stall Mats will be our provider. Please call them (see ad on page 17) directly. Both bedding and mats will be handled by them.

USEF REQUIREMENTS:

This show is licensed by USEF as a Competition Lite.


“EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

- Owners and riders are not required to be members of the Federation, but any competing member, 18 or older must have completed the SafeSport Training prior to the first day of competition.
- Anyone signing as trainer on the entry form, must be a competing member of USEF and must have completed the SafeSport Training prior to the first day of competition.

- Drug fees are not charged at a Competition Lite show, but any horse is subject to testing. Medication forms must be filed electronically.
- Lite Competitions will award half-value HOTY points to all USEF recorded horses, whose owner is a competing member.

USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT:

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

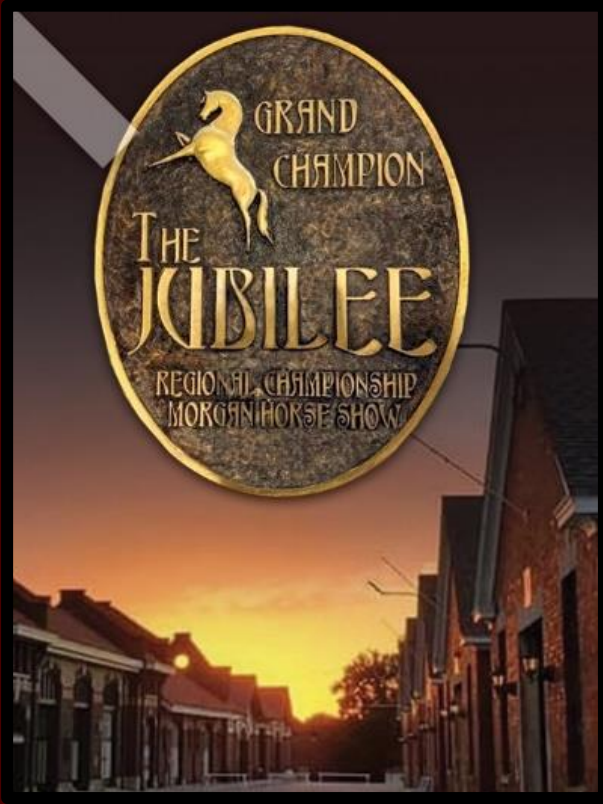

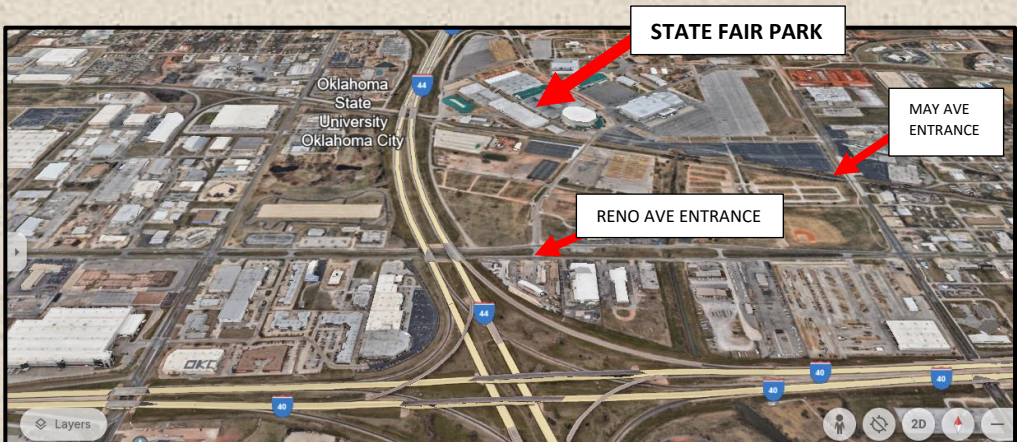
